

Operational Data Definition

Operational Data: “Operational data and information *created, used in, or in support of a combined/joint operation by the Combined/Joint Task Force headquarters, its components, and operating forces that support operational planning*, analysis, and assessment of friendly and enemy activity to **inform decisions** and increase operational effectiveness.”




Machine to machine data as well as unstructured data (word, excel, chat, power point, etc.)

An Historical Perspective



During both Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) and Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF), there were consistent and substantial gaps between the time operations commenced and implementation of an operational data structure to facilitate analysis for commanders. - **Commanders realized, after the fact, they need processes, personnel, and tools to manage data, information, and knowledge**
